Last year alone,


136,000

young people in the UK approached their local council for housing support.

Over the last 6 years, this has increased

58%

That's 372 young people asking for help every day.

young people are ready to move-on from temporary supported accommodation but are caught in the **affordability trap**.

- Brokering stunning accommodation at c. 50% discount


... which unblocks the system, offers homes and hope to young people affected by homelessness, and helps us and our industry partners impact 10,000 young people's lives over the next five years.
