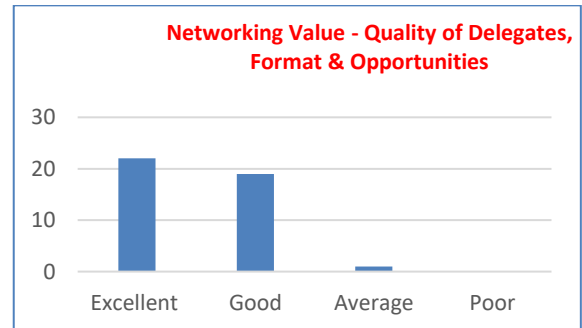
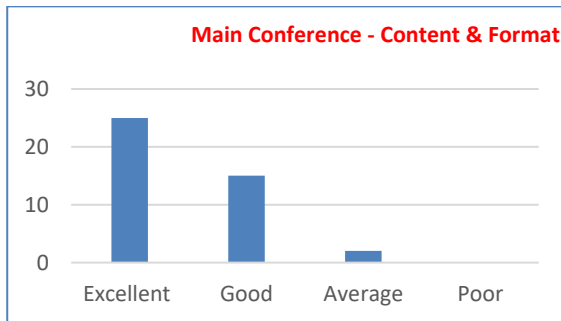
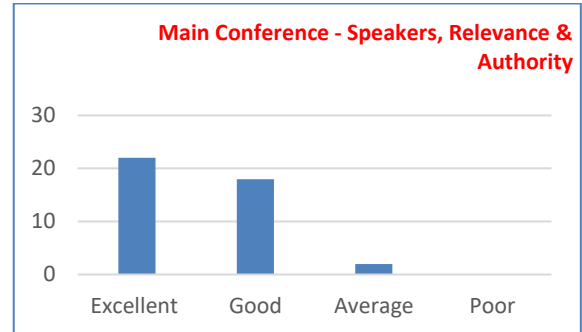

Positive Feedback

The conference was overwhelmingly a great success:

Negative Feedback

But there were some negative comments:

The only comments I would like to add would be that I would have found it more beneficial if there were more town planners/architects/developers there.”

“Loved the day, would have liked to see a few more exhibitors.”

It was a good event, however I would have like to hear more information on what the B2R product is.”

Event was fantastic, will definitely attend more in future – however as a FM Server provider, I am always shocked by how little people in the sector talk about FM Service delivery.”
