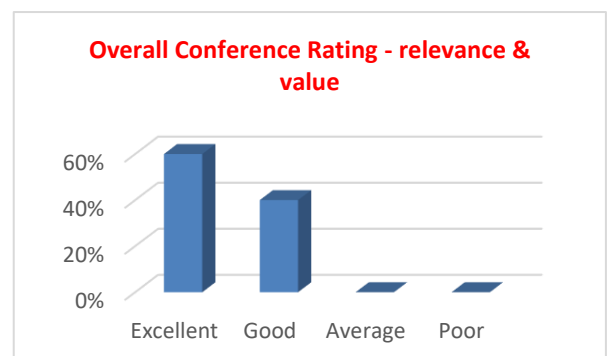
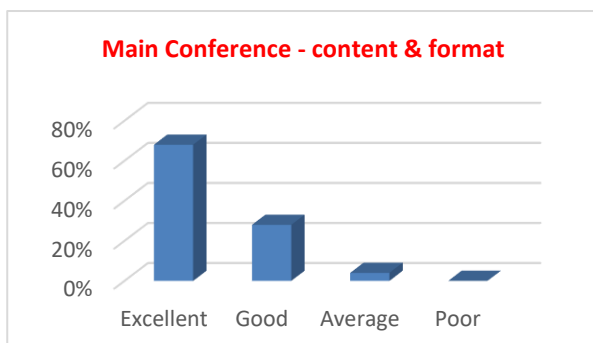
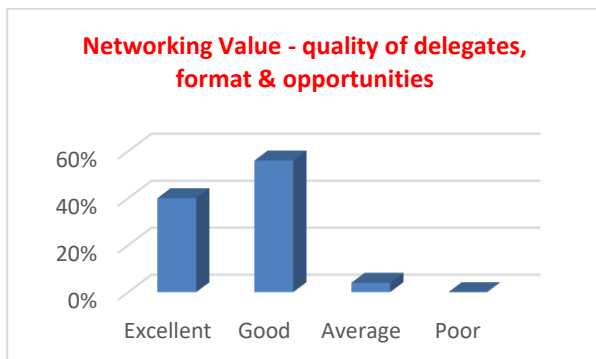
We had a full house, and from the feedback, this was another very successful BTR Forum – thanks to all of our contributors, leaders from both public and private sectors.

Positive Feedback

Negative Feedback
